## Kindergarten Music

Hello everyone! I miss you all so much! This week in Kindergarten music class we are working on our beat of silence - or "rest." You can check out the lessons posted in your McGraw Hill App in Classlink - there will be a new lesson on Wednesday about Listening for a Beat of Silence.



If you don't have access to the online music book you can make patterns using your music note and rest cards I sent home the first week. If you can't find your cards, line up a bunch of toys or objects from your house - clap and say "tah" when you see a toy and pull your hands apart when you do not see a toy for "rest." Listen to your favorite song - can you hear where the singer stops singing or the instruments stop playing? That's a rest! See how many you can find!

## 1st Grade Music

If you don't have access to the online book you can make up an ABA dance at home! Create two dance moves - one for A and a different dance for B. Perform your dance by doing the A dance, the B dance, and then the A dance again! Have instruments or homemade

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## 2nd Grade Music

Hello everyone! I miss you all so much! This week in 2nd grade music class we are working on reading, singing, and moving to Do, Re, Mi, So, and La. You can check out the lessons posted in your McGraw Hill App in Classlink - there will be a new lesson on Wednesday about Reading and Moving to Do, Re, Mi, Sol, and La.



If you don't have access to the online book you can use your music note cards and staff card I sent home the first week. If you can't find your staff card and note cards you can draw 5 horizontal lines on a piece of paper for the staff and small objects or pieces of paper to be the notes. Create patterns on the staff! If you're making your own staff choose one of the bottom lines to be "Do." Once you have chosen "Do" the next space is Re, the next line is Mi, skip the next space because that's "Fa" - the next line is Sol, and the next space is La. Create patterns and sing using the hand signs. Use the hand sign cards for help! If you have a keyboard or piano at home you can play these notes! Pick a note to start on - that's "Do." Do, Re, Mi, are all in a row - skip one! - then the next two are Sol and then La. You could also use the black keys on the piano - the set of 3 keys can be Do, Re, Mi and the set of 2 keys can be Sol and La. Play and create melodies - sing along!

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## 3rd Grade Music
